Sister M. John Bosco Crivello, 66 years old, a member of the Congregation of the Sisters of the Holy Family for 47 years and a resident at the Motherhouse in Fremont, California, entered into rest in Fremont on Friday, November 9, 2007. Sister John Bosco was born on April 29, 1941 in San Francisco, California to Michael and Norman Crivello.

Sister John Bosco entered the Congregation of the Sisters of the Holy Family on January 6, 1960. She ministered in various capacities as a Director of Religious Education, Adult Education Coordinator and Parish Associate in parishes throughout California, including Castro Valley, San Leandro and Fremont. Sister also served as Director of Religious Education for six years in Northern Nevada for the Dioceses of Reno and Las Vegas. The last few years Sister lived at the Motherhouse in Fremont. Although seriously ill, she continued her ministry of prayer.

Sister John Bosco lived in Reno, Nevada from 1975 to 1981 and served as Director of Religious Education in the Diocese of Reno/Las Vegas.

Sister John Bosco is survived by her sister, Joyce T. Crivello of Zephyr Cove, Nevada.
