

Sister M. Edwardine Bohan, a member of the Sisters of the Holy Family for 60 years, died in Fremont, California on Tuesday, June 2, 2009 at the age of 90. Sister Edwardine ministered in the Diocese of Oakland for many years at various parishes and served as Director of Saint Vincent's Day Home for 10 years from 1957 to 1967. Sister also ministered in the Archdiocese of San Francisco. Sister's last parish ministry assignment as CCD Principal took place at St. Felicitas in San Leandro from 1982 through 1993. For several years Sister lived at the San Jose Convent serving in Community Ministry before coming to the Motherhouse in Fremont ministering in the same capacity and in a Ministry of Prayer. A Mass of Resurrection was celebrated at the Motherhouse Chapel of the Sisters of the Holy Family, 159 Washington Blvd., Fremont, California, on June 5, 2009. Burial took place at Holy Cross Cemetery, Colma.
